### **Update from Jodi Lehr on Marco**

"Marco's Bone Marrow test was Leukemia Free. A long road to go but Cancer free at this state means the prognosis is very positive! We go back for another round of 5 days of intensive Chemo and it can go on like this for 3 + years to make sure it is out... or they may opt for Bone Marrow Transplant. The bottom line with ALL Leukemia (his strain) is that if it is not eliminated from bone marrow in 4-6 weeks of treatment, the prognosis is poor ... This gives him much better odds for the future.

The meals have been a God send! Our family sits down and eats a healthy meal daily... and it means so much!"
